GATE CLOSED @ 6:30 p.m.

- At this time, all buildings are closed to the public except for the abbey church, which will have scheduled access during the day. (Please see "Abbey Church" below.)
- NO ACCESS TO PUBLIC WASHROOMS.
- We are requiring visitors to wash their hands at the sink inside the entrance to the abbey church.
- We are asking visitors to postpone coming to the abbey church or to enjoy the grounds if they are ill or know they have had contact with someone who is ill with the coronavirus.
- We encourage everyone to practice a safe social distance of two meters to help protect each other from this virus.
- The guesthouse is closed indefinitely (See "Guesthouse" below).
